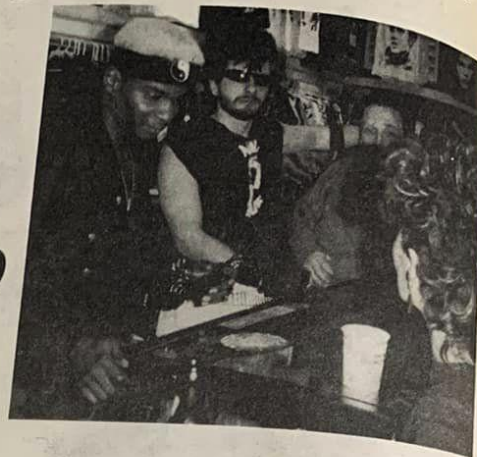


# Two Tone Heads Into Lucky Seventh



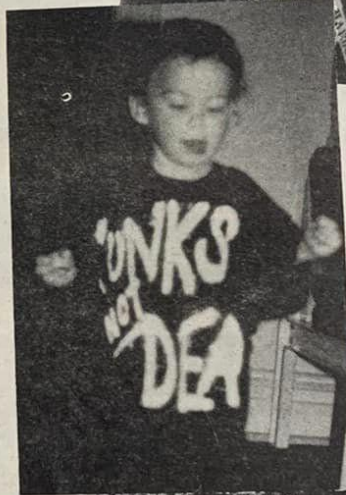
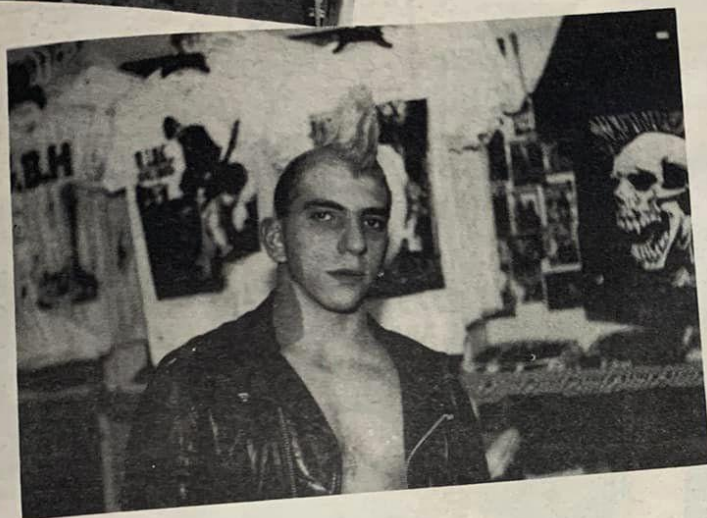
**R**oma and Iggy Goleczynski not only know what they like—they went out and did something about it.
